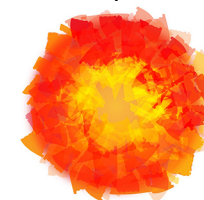
The support groups are very relaxed informal peer support meetings and a great way to share experiences with others who understand how you're feeling.
